December 19, 2011: The text of [Appendix D.3 APRA](#) has been updated to remove mention of the International X-ray Observatory and the Laser Interferometer Space Antenna. Also the names of the Technical Officers for some of the elements have been updated. The due date for notices of intent to propose and proposals remain unchanged at January 27, 2012 and March 23, 2012, respectively.

December 13, 2011. The start date for projects in [Appendix B.4 the Solar and Heliospheric Physics \(SHP\) program](#), was erroneously given as November 1, 2013. It should have been November 1, 2012.

November 2, 2011. To maintain consistency after the name of was [D.3](#) changed (by Amendment 30) other program elements that make reference to that call (D.1, D.2, D.4 & D.8) were corrected. The name and abbreviation of D.3 has been changed everywhere from Astrophysics Research and Enabling Technology (APRET) to Astrophysics Research and Analysis (APRA).

October 20, 2011. The original text of Appendixes [A.33 Disasters](#) and [A.35 Wildland Fires](#) indicated that copies of the statements of commitment from Co-Is should be included in the body of the proposal. That was an error and has been corrected. Instead, team members should indicate their participation online via NSPIRES. Letters of Support from End-User Organizations, if appropriate, should still included in the body of proposal. The due dates remain unchanged.

October 7, 2011. Appendix C.25, Mission Concept Development for Astrobiology Small Payloads, will not be solicited in ROSES 2011. SMD anticipates including it in ROSES 2012. This call for proposals has been deferred because the required program resources are currently not available.

September 16, 2011. The minimum requirement for 3 months of time for Co-Leaders has been removed from Section 2.4 of [Appendix A.31 the Science Definition Team For The Desdyni-Radar Mission](#).

September 7, 2011: New text has been added to the end of Section 1 of Appendix [A.28, Interdisciplinary Research in Earth Science](#) to Clarify the requirement that data used must be public.
